Five courses are required to complete the Graduate Certificate in Data Science and are available during the summer, fall, and spring semesters. Students who take two courses per semester can complete the certificate in one year. The five courses are:

- » **DS 700:** Foundations of Data Science
- » **DS 710:** Programming for Data Science
- » **DS 715:** Data Warehousing
- » **DS 735:** Communicating about Data
- » **DS 740:** Data Mining and Machine Learning

Optional Path to a Master's Degree

As a certificate student, you will take five courses from the online University of Wisconsin Master of Science in Data Science curriculum. Should you choose to continue your data science education, you will have the option to apply to the MS in Data Science program. Upon acceptance, you will work with your home campus to transfer your certificate coursework to the [MS in Data Science degree](#) program.

Admission Requirements

- » Bachelor's degree with cumulative GPA of 3.0. Students with a GPA of less than 3.0 may be considered for provisional admission based on a holistic review of all application materials.
- » Completed coursework and/or relevant work experience in elementary statistics, introductory computer programming, and introduction to databases.
